Airfreight

- Reduced capacity across all sectors due to lower passenger numbers
- · Pharma shipments take priority over general cargo bookings
- Spot rates very much prevalent- very few carriers have tariff rates
- From the 1st January 2021, the EU will no longer recognise UK RA or KC secure status as part of the
 EU secure supply chain for cargo carried by road (truck) from the UK to the EU for onward transfer
 by air. Due to this, all cargo bookings transiting the EU via road will be subject to screening charges
 even if delivered to us as known cargo



Seafreight

- CNY / Q1 Capacity Constraints potential impact for blank sailings / reduced equipment availability
- Cargo moving from a GB ports to any port in the Rest of the World (RoW) on a vessel which is then
 transiting via an EU port will require an ENS to be filed the Ocean Carrier in advance of vessel arrival
 at the GB loading port.
- To enable Ocean Carriers to make the ENS for a vessel departing a GB port it will be necessary
 to receive Export Shipping Instructions (SI) from all Export customers a minimum of 72 hours (3
 calendar days) prior to vessel arrival at GB loading port.

Brexit

- Brexit has now happened, little impact at present as UK Importers/Exporters have stocked up
- New requirement for clearance at border
- Transport congestion at ports eased

Covid-19 Pandemic

- UK now in national lockdown
- Daily cases exceeding 50k
- Work from home directive, except for key workers
- Schools closed; workforce reduced for parents providing childcare

New warehouse in Sweden

With the expansion of business, Premiere Logistics has established a new distribution center in Sweden. The warehouse is located in the western Industrial Estate on the outskirts of Gothenburg, Sweden. Premiere Logistics occupies the office space above the warehouse itself, with the warehouse being operated by different company.



The warehouse location is within a reasonable distance away from **GOT** airport and Gothenburg seaport, which distance by 36KM and 11KM respectively. Which able to control the transportation time of these two ports around half an hour, providing time benefits to our partners. Also, it is very efficient for both air and sea cargo. For air cargo, it only take around 28 minutes from the warehouse to GOT airport. And only take around 11 minutes. It opens up the capability to handle some urgent cargo delivery from warehouse to the ports.

Except for the geographic advantage, the security facility of the warehouse is also worth mentioning. The office area is accessed via an electronic lock mechanism. Doors are alarmed with contract switched linking to Securitas (outsourced security company). And there is one police station very near the warehouse, on 2.4 km, 4 mins driving by car. Also, the warehouse area we will use is only visited during the day time by the company of staffs.

Moreover, the warehouse has both a surveillance camera and a heat sensor to protect the storage area. Two cameras inside the warehouse and these are effectively cover all entry/exit doors/windows to the warehouse, including the dock doors. And planned one more camera will specify monitoring premiere cargo, enhancing the security level. The surveillance camera is HD version and can follow the object by a certain distance. And the heat sensor system is very sensitive to detecting target, even a small animal running across the camera is still able to chase it and identify it.

Furthermore, as mention above, the heat sensor is installed and active 24/7. If any fire accident hall, the heat camera turns red the fire spot could be seen from the camera inside, and the duty person calls the fire brigade directly. And according to research, heat sensors will have a quicker response time than smoke detectors.

Service Update—Herco Freight, USA



Herco Freight Forwarders INC. considered a problem faced by an airline that operates several parallel flights to transport cargo between a particular origin destination pair.

The airline can sell its cargo capacity either through allotment contracts or on the spot market where customers exhibit choice behavior between different flights. The goal is to simultaneously select allotment contracts among available bids and find a booking control policy for the spot market to maximize the sum of the profit from the allotments and the total expected profit from the spot market.

We @Hercofreight, formulate the booking control problem on the sport market as a dynamic program and construct approximations to its

value functions, which can be used to estimate the total expected profit from the spot market. We show that our value function approximations provide upper bounds on the optimal total expected profit from the spot market and they allow us to solve the allotment selection problem through a sequence of linear mixed integer programs with a special structure.

Furthermore, the value function approximations are useful for constructing a booking control policy for the spot market with desirable monotonic properties.

Computational experiments show that the proposed approach can be scaled to realistic problems and provides well performing allotment allocation and booking control decisions.

IMPACTS OF CHINESE NEW YEAR HOLIDAY

The commercial relationship between Brazil and China is quite significant and with important participation in the supply of products to Brazil. However, for the good progress of business, it is necessary attention with some differences in the local calendar, such as the **Chinese New Year Holiday**. This year 2021, the Chinese New Year period will be from **11 to 17 February**, therefore, the operation of the companies in China is **suspended** due to the holiday.

As a result of the pandemic, we are facing serious instability in the dynamics of space on vessels and volatility of the sea freight prices. With the gradual reopening of the market, and therefore of ports, the demand for exports from Chinese ports has increased exponentially, resulting in a **shortage of space and equipment**, generating a scenario similar to a daily auction for sea freight prices. Due to the the current market situation and in addition to the Chinese holiday period, the tendency is to worsen the disorder and slow the normalization of this chaotic situation, which can take us to the **second semester** of the year.

Due to the numerous obstacles during this period, please be sure that your logistical planning is well defined and keep an eye on the schedule and deadlines, because all services affect the import process. Anticipation of orders and freight bookings, keep in mind that prices may increase and planning of the shipments schedule are key points at this time. It is necessary to establish **good partnerships** and be aware that the situation requires **patience** and **understanding of the risks**.

How to Handle Logistics During Chinese New Year

With Chinese New Year approaching fast workers will travel throughout the country to return to their families and celebrate the New Year, with all manufacturing shutting down for the duration.

The country will celebrate from Feb. 15 -21 but most factories will stop operations until March 2.

For U.S. companies importing or exporting goods from/to China this can be a considerable challenge.

"Planning and preparation are key to effectively navigating and managing challenges that could occur during the Chinese New Year," said Frank Guenzerodt. "By implementing a few critical steps in advance of the holiday, shippers can avoid unnecessary bottlenecks and continue business with little or no interruption."

One to two weeks before CNY, factories will speed up their production causing a surge of freight. During CNY they will close down completely. Production will resume after and be back to normal one to two weeks after the holidays.

There are two celebrations that occur during this time, the Official Holiday and the Traditional Holiday. It is due to this that some factories will finish earlier than others and take longer vacations. Some suppliers are off for more than a month.

Guenzerodt outlines what can happen during this time and how to prepare for it.

How to Handle Logistics During Chinese New Year

How CNY can affect your business:

- --Longer production and quotation times: Production time will be delayed and quotation requests will be processed slower.
- --Decreased staff: Some factory workers decide not return to their workplace after the holidays. This high turnover means that previously estimated production times may need to be extended.
- --Production queues: The later that orders are submitted, the further back in the production queue they will placed. With one month worth of orders backed up, factories will first process orders from their preferred partners.

How you can prepare:

- --Build up sufficient stock, considering a period of up to four weeks after Chinese New Year.
- --Provide a forecast of your expected cargo to your shipper's representative.
- --Inform your shipper about your priority shipments, in case there are only very limited spaces.
- --Reserve space on passenger flights for shipments which cannot be delayed. The rates are slightly higher but this measure will keep your supply chain running.
